

**IGGLESDEN, Mr John**

1762 to 1773 Occupied Lockskinners and Tyehurst farms and Paynes Land, tenant of Streatfeild

1772 Mrs Streatfeild leased Lockskinners to him for 8 years.

**INCLEDON, John, wife Sarah**

1747 Daughter Mary who married (spinster) Robert Nightingale in 1774. Witnesses: William Nightingale, Sarah Driver

1753 Daughter Sarah. She died in 1770.

1752 Thomas Butcher left property to Sarah Incledon, his daughter, and to Mary Incledon his granddaughter.

1754 Death of John Incledon, of smallpox

1761 Elizabeth, base daughter of widow Incledon. She died the same year

1769 to 1798 Widow Incledon held a property at Cares Corner.

1770 Witnessed marriage of James Jenner and Sarah Taylor

**INGRAM, Abel**

1740 Death

**INGRAM, John, wife Mary**

1727 to 1746 Occupied Gildridge, tenant of Woodgate.

1740 John Ingram married Mary King

1743 Daughter Mary

1748 Son John

1749 Death of Mary Ingram

1752 Son Robert

1761 Witnessed will of John Piggott, husbandman.

1785 (senior) Relief 3s. (continued)

**INGRAM, Henry, husbandman, wife Sarah**

1751 Acknowledged by Brasted to Chiddingstone with children Sarah, Elizabeth and Mercy.

1752 to 1762 Occupied Clinton Brook tenant of Cronk.

**INGRAM, Thomas, wife Sarah, Else**

1753 Thomas Ingram married Sarah Nightingale

1754 Son Thomas who died the same year.

1754 Son John

1756 Son Thomas

1756 to 1777 Held Great Sheffield in succession to Thomas Taylor.

1757 Son William who died the same year (infant)

1758 Daughter Sarah

1760 Daughter Ann

1761 Daughter Mary

1762 Succeeded Henry Ingram as the occupant of Clinton Brook, tenant of Cole.

1763 Son Philip

1767 Son Henry

1768 Son William

1773 Death of Sarah Ingram

1777 (widower) Thomas Ingram married Else Smith. Witness: Edward Hoasel?

1777 Witnessed marriage of John Bravery of Penshurst and Mary Waters.

1779 Occupied Little Buckhurst farm (Walnut Tree Cross) in conjunction with the owner John Everest

**INGRAM, Robert**

1752 Death

**INGRAM, Philip**

1762 to 1765 Occupied Polebrook farm, tenant of Burgis.

**INGRAM, Thomas, wife Martha**

1778 Son Thomas

1815 Death of Martha, aged 69. (monument in churchyard).

**INGRAM, John, wife Dorothy**

1779 John Ingram of Chiddingstone married Dorothy Wickenden at Penshurst.

1780 Daughter Mary who died in 1781 (infant)

1781 Son John

1783 (junior) Son James

1784 to 1785 Paid to keep Earl's girl Mary at 1s a week. **This could be John Ingram senior**

1785 Dame Ingram was paid 6d for mending for the poor. (continued).

**INKPIN, Sarah**

1770 Married John Cooper of Chiddingstone at Hever. Witnesses: John Hollans, Daniel Chapman

**IRELAND, Hannah**

1778 Death
