1735 Son Thomas. He witnessed the marriage of Rebecca Jacob in 1762

1738 Daughter Rebecca. She married Robert Lee of Leigh in 1762.

JACOB, John, son of John Jacob above, wife Sarah

1754 Bore witness in the prosecution of John Durrant and John Baker, servants of Mr Bernard Hyde. (Quarter Sessions).

JEAL, James, wife Ann

1778 James Jeal of Brasted, bachelor, married Ann Kingswood. Witnesses: John Kingswood, Anne Kingswood.

1781 Son John

JEFFERY, Sarah

1784 Sarah Jeffery married Jonathan May. Witnesses: William Young, Sarah Bowra?

1752 Death

JENNER, William, wife Jane

1730 Married Jane Hersey at Hever

1726 Thomas Gilbert left Bassetts to his widow Clemence, remainder to John Jenner of Leigh, husbandman, and after him to his son William Jenner. (Will PS)

JENNER, John

1741 to 1778 John Jenner owned a moiety of two cottages at Chiddingstone Causeway formerly part of Bassetts.

1778 He had alienated the above property to Thomas Hoare his son-in-law (manor of Sundridge Weald)

1775 Death. An Ann Jenner died soon afterwards.

JENNER, James, wife Ann

1770 James Jenner, bachelor, married Ann Hollamby. Witnesses: Ingledon, Sarah Taylor

1771 Son William

1773 Daughter Elizabeth

1775 Daughter Sarah

1777 Daughter Mary

1779 Son James

1782 Son Abraham

1782 Occupied a property in Chiddingstone North , tenant of Richard Allnutt, esq

1784 to 1785 Parish paid his rent to Mr Allnutt £2-10s.

1785 Parish supplied him with pease 9s 6d. His boy and his girl kept by George Kidder for 1s 6d a week. A gown made for his daughter 1s. (continued).

JENNER, Jeremiah, wife Sarah

1775 Jeremiah Jenner, bachelor, married Sarah Streeter Witness: John Weller

1777 Son John who died

1778 Son Richard

JESSOP, Richard

1738 His land lay west of Willmore Land.

JESSOP, Elizabeth

1745 Daughter Mary

1746 ? Spinster, of Chiddingstone, married William Hall, bachelor, of Eynsford, husbandman at the Fleet

JESSOP, John, wife Mary

1732 John Jessop occupied a messuage and 11 acres in Chiddingstone, tenant of John Cronk, carpenter

1747 Son John

JESSOP, Mary

1758 Mary Jessop of Sevenoaks married Thomas Hayes. Witness: Thomas Humphrey.

JESSOP, Mary

1761 Base son John. Mary was paid 4s relief.

JESSOP, Mercy

1762 Base son John Mills

JEWELL, William, of Bradbourne, Sevenoaks, gent, wife Margaret

1730 Will (PCC) Great Brownings farm in Chiddingstone bequeathed to wife Margaret, remainder to son William. Sister Overy deceased. Also Breeches farm.

JEWELL, William, of Sevenoaks, son of William Jewell above. Wife Hester.

1730 to 1762 Owned Great Brownings and Breeches farms in Chiddingstone

1746 Mr William Jewell for a property near hale Lane occupied by William Muggridge (manor of Chiddingstone-Cobham)

1762 Death. Will (PCC). He left all his messuages in Chiddingstone, Penshurst, Leigh and Hartley to his wife Hester, remainder to his cousin Elizabeth Selby.

1762 to 1773 Great Brownongs and Breeches farms were owned by Mrs Jewell. She was succeeded by Mr Selby.

JEWELL, James

1776 Witnessed marriage of James Carden of Colsden and Ann Longley

JONES, Thomas, wife Susannah

1738 Daughter Susannah

1738 Death of wife Susan

JONES, Edward, wife Elizabeth, travellers. Married at Portslade in Sussex. Parishioners of Tonbridge.

1747 Daughter Leticia

JONES, Milton

1755 (spinster) Married Thomas Coller. Witnesses: John Curreck, Thomas Oliver

JONES, Francis, wife Susanna

1762 to 1765 Occupied Skinners, tenant of Driver

1765 Son John

JONES, Mary

1784 Witnessed marriage between James Campfield of Chelsfield and Mercy Denton.

JONES, John

1784 Death (infant)

JORDAN, -----, a travelling woman

1743 Death

JUNDALL, Edmund

1741 Clement Gilbert had alienated a moiety of two cottages at Chiddingstone Causeway formerly part of Bassetts to Edmund Jundall.

1743 Edmund Jundall had alienated the above property to Thomas Nye. (manor of Sundridge Weald)

JUPP, Thomas, wife Elizabeth

1762 Thomas Jupp married Elizabeth Ashdown. Witness: Mary Cronk

1762 Daughter Sarah who died in 1763
