I Benjamin Bawring of Sumpsheld in the County of Surry being of a sound and disposing mind memory and understanding praised be god for the same do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in writing in manner following that is to say first I desire that all such just debts as I shall owe at the time of my decease and my funeral and testamentary expences shall be paid and discharged by my Executors and Executrix hereinafter named from and out of the residue of my personal estate and I do nominate make and appoint my Wife Martha Bawring and also my two brothers in Law Francis a Glover of Westham in the County of Kent and also George Glover of Saded in the said County of Surry Heoman Executors and Executrix of this my will also I give and bequeath unto my said Executors and Executrix the sum of five hundred pounds cash for the trouble they shall have in the execution of the trusts hereby in them reposed and all the rest residue and remainder of my monies and securities for money household goods and other goods chattels effects and a personal estate whatsoever and subject to the payment thereof of my just debts and my funeral and testamentary expences I do give and bequeath the same unto my said Executors and Executrix the said Francis Glover and George Glover and my Wife Martha Bawring in trust nevertheless to convert the same into monies in the best way and manner that they can and will and get in all monies due and owing unto me upon bonds bills notes or otherwise and upon further trust to pay apply and dispose of the monies to be arise from such residuum of personal estate in manner following that is to say I order and direct that one half part of the amount thereof shall be laid out for the purchasing principal stock of the three per cent reduced annuities of the Bank of England also I give and bequeath unto my said dear Wife Martha Bawring the yearly interest or dividends of the said principal stock to be so purchased as heretofore directed for and during her natural life also I give and bequeath the remaining half part of my personal estate unto and equally between my six children namely George Glover Bawring Benjamin Bawring Martha Bawring Samuel Bawring Sarah Bawring and Thomas Bawring share and share alike or their respective Executors or Administrators to whom I give and bequeath the same and to be paid within twelve months after my decease and immediately after my said Wife Martha Bawring's decease I do hereby that the principal stock or sum thereof before directed to be purchased in the three per cent reduced annuities of the Bank of England to be paid or transferred unto or amongst my said six children George Glover Bawring Benjamin Bawring Martha Bawring Samuel Bawring Sarah Bawring and Thomas Bawring in equal parts or shares or their respective Executors or Administrators to whom I give and bequeath the same and I hereby declare that it shall and may be lawful to and for my said Executors in a Executrix and Trustees to take and pay themselves all their reasonable charges and expenses in and concerning the due execution and performance of the said trust out of any the trust monies which shall come to this or their

hands by virtue of the Executorship and trust and hereby revoke all other Wills by me made I declare this only to be my last Will and Testament In witness whereof I the said Benjamin Bawring the Testator have in presence of my friends and affixed my seal the sixteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and six Benjamin Bawring. Signed sealed published and declared as and for his last Will and Testament in the presence of us who in this presence and at his request and in the presence of each other have signed our hands as witnesses attesting the Execution thereof. Proved at London 12th July 1821 before the Worshipful Charles M. Coote Doctor of Laws and Surrogate by the Oaths of Francis Glover and George Glover two of the Exors to whom Admon was granted having been first sworn duly to Adm^r power reserved to Martha Bawring Widow the Relict the other Exor.
