Will made 19th October 1848, probate 11th November 1851

This is the Last Will and Testament of me Elizabeth Oxley of the Parish of Heathfield in the County of Sussex Spinster First I order and direct that all my lawful debts funeral and testamentary expenses be paid by my Executor hereinafter named from and out of my Estate I give unto each of the surviving children of my late **brother William Oxley** the sum of nineteen pounds and nineteen shillings (except his youngest son Samuel Oxley he having already received his share) I give unto each of the surviving children of my niece Sarah **Oxley** the sum of five pounds I give unto the two sons of my nephew Nicholas Oxley each ten pounds I give unto the widow of my nephew the late William Oxley of Herstmonceux ten pounds and to each of her surviving children ten pounds I give unto each of the surviving children of my sister the late Susan Funnell nineteen pounds and nineteen shillings I give unto the grand children of the said Susan Funnell namely George Verrall William Verrall and Ruth Verrall five pounds each I give unto Mary Feist late Mary Lower five pounds I give unto Mary Oxley widow of the late David Oxley five pounds I give unto **Ellen Twort** five pounds | give unto **Sarah Weekes** ten pounds | give unto **Thomas Baker** son of the late Samuel Baker five pounds I give unto each of the surviving children of the late John Baker five pounds All the residue of my estate and effects whatsoever and wheresoever I give unto Richard Lower of Chiddingly Land Surveyor whom I do also hereby constitute and appoint the sole Executor of this my will And I do hereby revoke all former wills by me made declaring this and this only to be my last Will and Testament In witness whereof I the said Elizabeth Oxley have hereunto signed my name this nineteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty eight.
