Will made 15 December 1541, probate 15 February 1541/2

In the name of god amen The yere of or lord god a thousand fyve hundred fourtie and one and the xv daie of Decembr I Richard Isted of the pishe of Maighfeld in the Countie of Sussex and wthin the diocs of Canterbery hole of mynde and in good memory being thanks being unto Almighty god do make and ordeyn this my present Testament and last will in maner and forme folowing / First I give and bequeth my soule unto Almightie god my maker and redemer to our blessed lady seynt Mary the virgyn and to all the holy company of hevyn and my body to be buryed whereas yt shall please Almightie god and my rulers/ Item I give and bequeth unto the mother churche of seynt Mighell of Southmalling xijd Item I give and bequeth unto the high aulter of Maighfeld for my tythes necligently forgotten or wthholden viiid Item I give and bequeath unto the high aulter of Framfeld viijd Item I give and bequeth unto evry of my daughters mariage that ys to sey to Margaret Annes Elizabeth Elyn Alice and Dorothe xxli apece/ Item I give and bequeth unto evry of my godchildren vid apece/ Item the residue of all my goodes catall and woode bothe standing lying and groyng/ the whiche I have bought cole and myne I give and bequeth unto Joane my wyfe duryng her widowhode and yf she fortune to mary agayn then I will that all my quycke catell shalbe shyfte indefferently betwene my children betwixt the seyd Joane and me laufully begotten and then the seyd woodes and farme the which I have lying and being wthin the p[ar]isshes of Maighfeld aforeseyd and Hethfeld to remayn unto Richard Isted my sone The Resydue of all my goodes and catalls my bequethes and my detts payd I give and bequeth unto the seyd Joane my wyfe whome I make and ordeyn my sole Executrice and Richard Brymsted and John Slade to be myne overseers and every of them to have for theyr labor vis viiid apece

This is the last wyll of me above namyd Richard Isted made the daye and yere above wrytten/
First I will that Joane my wyfe shall have my landes called Agasland lying and being within the
pysh of Waldern and a pece of ground percell of varonhaugh and two other peces of grounde
called Martens Jes and Upper Jes set lying and being wthin the the pishe of maighfeld during her
wedowhode And after that the seyd landes to remayne unto the child the whiche my seyd
wyfe ys now grete with all yf it be a man childr and to his heyres and for defaulte of suche
heyres I will all the sayd landes shall remayne unto Richard Isted my sone and to his heires/
and for defaulte of suche heyres I will all the sayd landes shall remayne unto Annes my
doughter and to her heires and for default of such heires I will all the sayd landes shall remayn
unto Elyn her syster and to her heires and for default of heyre to Elizabeth her Syster and her
heires and for default of heire I will all the sayd landes shall remayn unto Alice her suster and
to her heires and for defaulte of heire I will all the sayd landes shall remayn unto Dorothe her
Syster and her heires and for default of heire I will all the said landes shall remayne unto Joane

Appys my doughter and to her heires. Item I will that Joane my seyd wyfe shall have all my lands and tents the whiche I dyd lately bye and purchas of William Dalyngton lying and being within the pishe of Framfeld during her wedowhode and after that I will that all the sayd tent and lands shall remayn unto Joane Appis my doughter and to her heires. Item I will that Richard my sone after the deceasse of Joane my wyfe shall have my tent and lands called the mote to hym and to his heires of the child whiche my sayd wyfe now goith with all be a man child Then I will all the sayd chylde the which my sayd wyfe nowe goith with all be a man child then I will all the seyd tents and lands called the mote shall remayn unto hym and to his heires. And for default of suche heire all the sayd lands and tenements shall remayn to my seyd doughters in maner and forme as Agasland and other before ys specified and shewed. And so Jhesus have mercy on me and all Cristens. These being wittnes. Rychard Russell de Waldern. John Baker William Cowper. Sir Robert Mott preest. Richard Brynsted. John Smyth. William Ayerst and others.
